TO ALL CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH, NEW JERSEY AN ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers by (Chapter 251 of the Laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, NJSA App. A:9-30 et seq; NJSA 40:48-1 (6)); NJSA 2C:33-1 et seq.; New Jersey Office Emergency Management Directive No. 61; whichever law or laws apply, a local disaster emergency declared to exist within the boundaries of the Township of Greenwich; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorized the promulgation of such orders, rules and regulations are necessary to meet the various problems which have or may occur due to such emergency; and

WHEREAS, by reason of related conditions resulting from Novel Coronavirus Pandemic being referred to as COVID-19, and designated a National and Statewide Public Health Emergency which currently threatens and or exist in certain areas of the Township of Greenwich, which may affect the health, safety and welfare of the people of the Township of Greenwich; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that these areas of the Township of Greenwich should then be declared disaster areas and further that certain measures must be taken in order to ensure that authorities will be unhampered in their efforts to maintain law and order as well as maintaining an orderly flow of traffic, and further in order to protect the persons and property of the residents affected by conditions; and

WHEREAS, the following areas are designated disaster areas: Township of Greenwich

THEREFORE, in accordance with the aforesaid laws, it is promulgated and declared that the following regulations shall be in addition to all other laws of the state of New Jersey and of the Township of Greenwich.

1. Township of Greenwich, through the Office of Emergency Management, can employ and deploy any and all resources under the townships control.
2. Issue any regulations it deems necessary in support of emergency operations.
